Of the 1,160 letters exchanged between John and Abigail Adams featured on this website, all but one are part of the Adams Family Papers of the Massachusetts Historical Society. (One letter from John to Abigail, 23 June 1780, is from the Warren-Adams Collection of the Massachusetts Historical Society.)

About the Correspondence between John and Abigail Adams

Abigail Adams became an inveterate letter writer. Gelles writes that over 2,300 of Abigail's letters have been preserved, with 430 selected for inclusion in this LOA volume, with about 100 of these published for the first time. The volume also includes Abigail Adams' will and selections from her diary on returning to America from Europe in 1788.
